

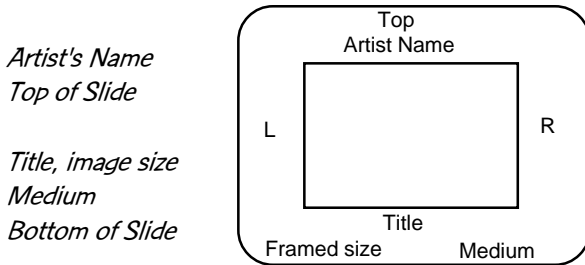
METHOD OF ENTRY

1. Up to 4 entries per artist may be made either 2" x 2" slide or by digital images on a CD.

2. Fee is \$8.00 for each entry. Entry fee is non-refundable. Please make checks payable to: Depot Art Center.

3. Entries must be received by 4:00 p.m. on May 28, 2010. Information recorded on the entry form is considered final and may not be changed.

4. **Slide entries** must be labeled as follows:



Do not use tape on slides. Glass slides are not acceptable. Slide submissions will be returned **ONLY** if they are accompanied by a self addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) that has adequate postage. Slides for accepted work may be claimed by the artist at the Depot Art Center and Gallery at the end of the show.

5. **CD entries** must be in jpeg or tiff format and no more than 2 meg in size. Each file must have the title of the image (or an abbreviation if a long title), the artist's last name, and the number of the corresponding image that is on the written entry form. Please label the CD with a Sharpie pen with the entrant's name. Label the CD case also with the entrant's name and address. Do not affix paper label to CD. Only the images entered should be on the CD. If the CD's are to be returned, enclose an envelope large enough to hold the CD with enough postage for the return.

CD's of accepted art work will be kept by the Depot until the show ends, at which time they may be claimed by the artist.

ABOUT THE DEPOT

The historic Depot Art Center & Gallery is a restored 1885 Santa Fe train station adapted to use as a gallery which opened in 1978. It was enhanced by the addition of a renovated 1890's caboose, which rests on a short section of track north of the red and green building. Located on a site near the railroad tracks, it is a successful and unique center in a marriage of community spirit and the arts. There are frequent workshops, programs and art classes at the Depot. In addition, there are regular monthly exhibits by members of the Littleton Fine Arts Guild. The Depot Art Center & Gallery is under the administration of the Littleton Museum and the City of Littleton and directed by the Littleton Fine Arts Guild. DELIVERY AND PICK-UP

Detailed instructions for the time and place of delivery of accepted work, as well as pick-up at the end of the show, will be included in notification of acceptance. Labels for accepted work will also be sent at that time. At the time of delivery the juror reserves the right to reject any pieces he considers unacceptable.

LIABILITY

The Depot Art Center & Gallery will take the utmost care in handling submitted slides, CDs and accepted artwork. However, neither the Littleton Fine Arts Guild, the Depot Art Center & Gallery nor the City of Littleton will be responsible for any damage to the slides, CDs or accepted artwork which might occur. Each artist is encouraged to carry his or her own insurance for transporting and during the exhibit. The submission of any entry constitutes the artist's waiver of any claim for damage or loss against the Littleton Fine Arts Guild, the Depot Art Center & Gallery or the City of Littleton.

STORAGE

The Depot Art Center & Gallery has no facilities for storing or shipping art work; therefore, all work must be delivered and picked up at the Depot on the designated day at the designated time.

BIN WORK

Bin work properly covered with acetate will be accepted from any artist who submitted entries. Limit: 5 bin pieces per artist. Bin work is not juried. A 30% commission will be collected on bin work sold. An inventory sheet in duplicate will be included with notification letters. Bin work must be numbered to correspond with the inventory sheet. Delivery of bin work should be made by Sunday July 25, 2010, 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. unless other arrangements are made.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to any artist residing in Colorado. All work must be original work of the submitting artist and current (within the last 3 years) and shall be for sale. Computer generated art will not be accepted. Art work is limited in size to 4' x 5' - outside framed dimension. The Depot Art Center & Gallery reserves the right to reject any work that does not match the submitted slide or CD, or is not properly presented for exhibit.

CATEGORIES

Two and three dimensional art work, including traditional and digital photography, sculpture, ceramics, fiber/textile, glass & jewelry **are acceptable**. If work is 3 dimensional, sending 2 or 3 views is suggested.

JUROR: GENE YOUNGMAN

Gene Youngman has been painting watercolors for over thirty years in Colorado. After thirty years of teaching art, twenty-five of that teaching drawing at Golden High School in Jefferson County Schools, he retired in May 2003 to paint full time. Today he spends much of the warmer months painting on location along the Front Range of the Colorado Rockies and in the foothills west of Denver. His paintings are regularly included in national, regional and local exhibitions, and are in many private and corporate collections. He has juried exhibitions for many art organizations in Colorado and teaches workshops about painting on location. His experience as a teacher of drawing, a potter, a painter and a photographer give him vast knowledge to draw upon for jurying. He is a past president of the Colorado Watercolor Society and Signature member of both the Rocky Mountain Media Society and Colorado Watercolor Society. His works are known for the under painting glow of his paintings and the use of purple shadows, as he enjoys painting the affect light has on natural and architectural subjects. Awards include the Irving Shapiro Memorial Watercolor Award from the Northern Colorado Artist Association at the Lincoln Center in Fort Collins, Colorado and numerous Merit and Place Awards from other recent exhibitions. He is a regular participant in plein air events in Colorado including the "Paint the Park" Event in Estes Park in August each year. His work can be seen at the Georgetown Gallery.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

The Depot Art Center & Gallery will accept **only** art work with professional presentation. Art work should be appropriately framed with wire on the back for hanging. Items should be framed and/or edges adequately finished on the art piece. Sculpture and free standing pieces must be stable and able to be displayed safely on a flat surface.

AWARDS

The Depot Art Center & Gallery will give 5 cash awards to artists selected by our juror. Our sponsors may also present awards to the artists of their choice, or to the jurors honorable mentions, should the sponsor not be able to be present, these awards of cash or merchandise will be presented at the reception on August 7th 5 - 8 p.m.. Last year's awards totaled more than \$1,000.

SALES

Every effort is made to promote sales. A 30% commission is charged on sales while work is in the possession of the Depot Art Center & Gallery.
